brokenness with our earthly fathers

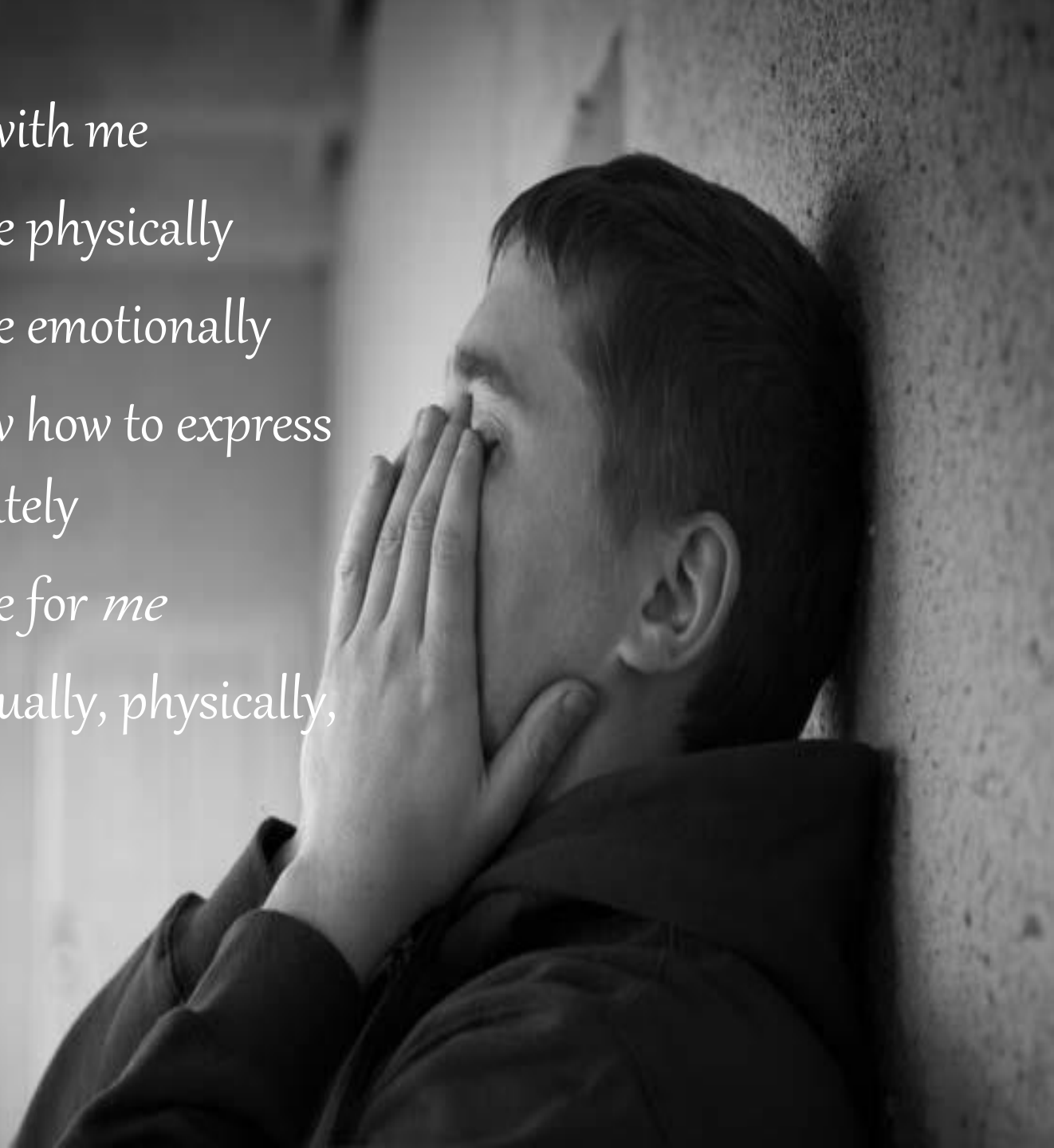






# God Chose Abraham to reflect His nature as “Father”

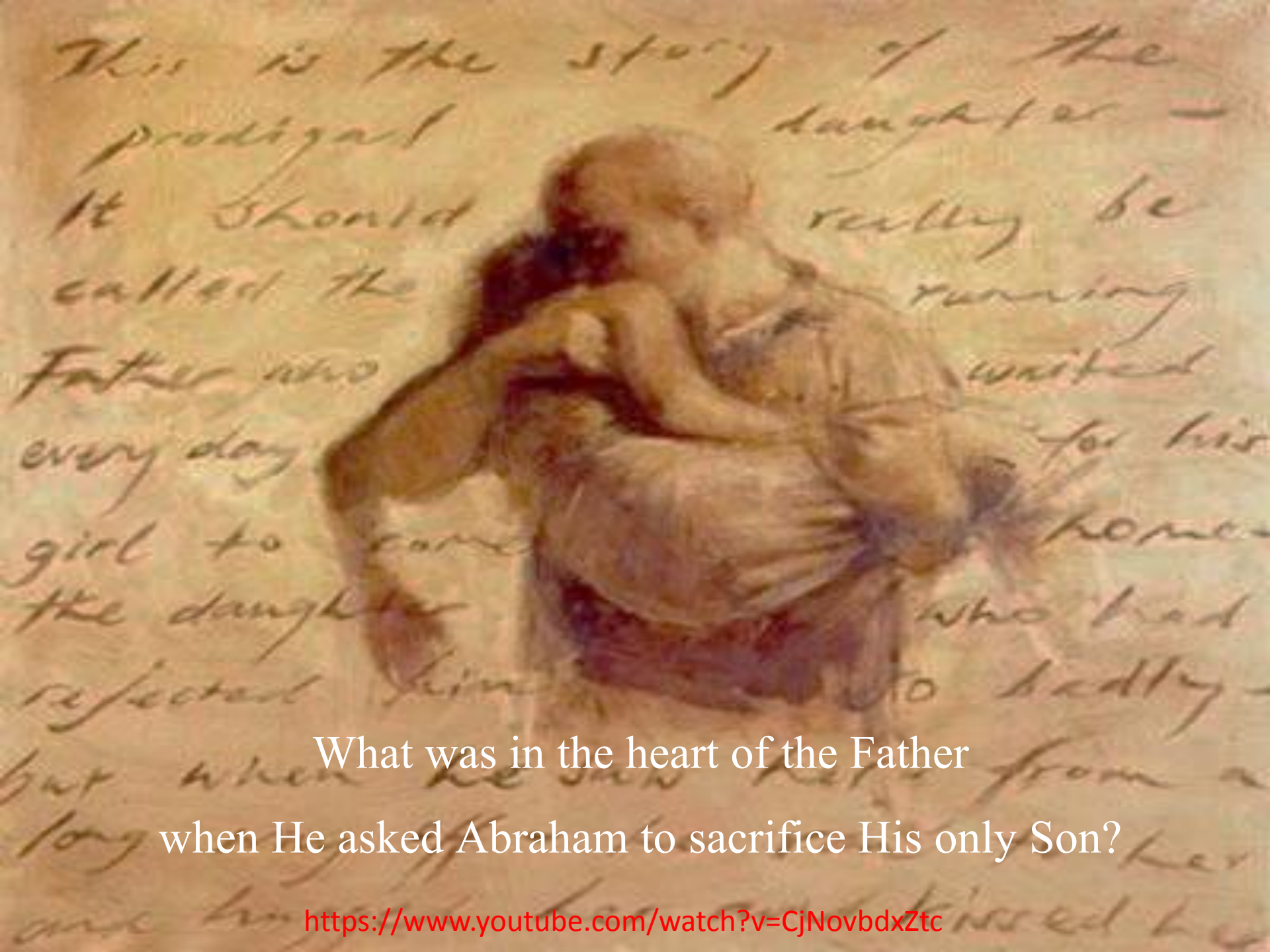

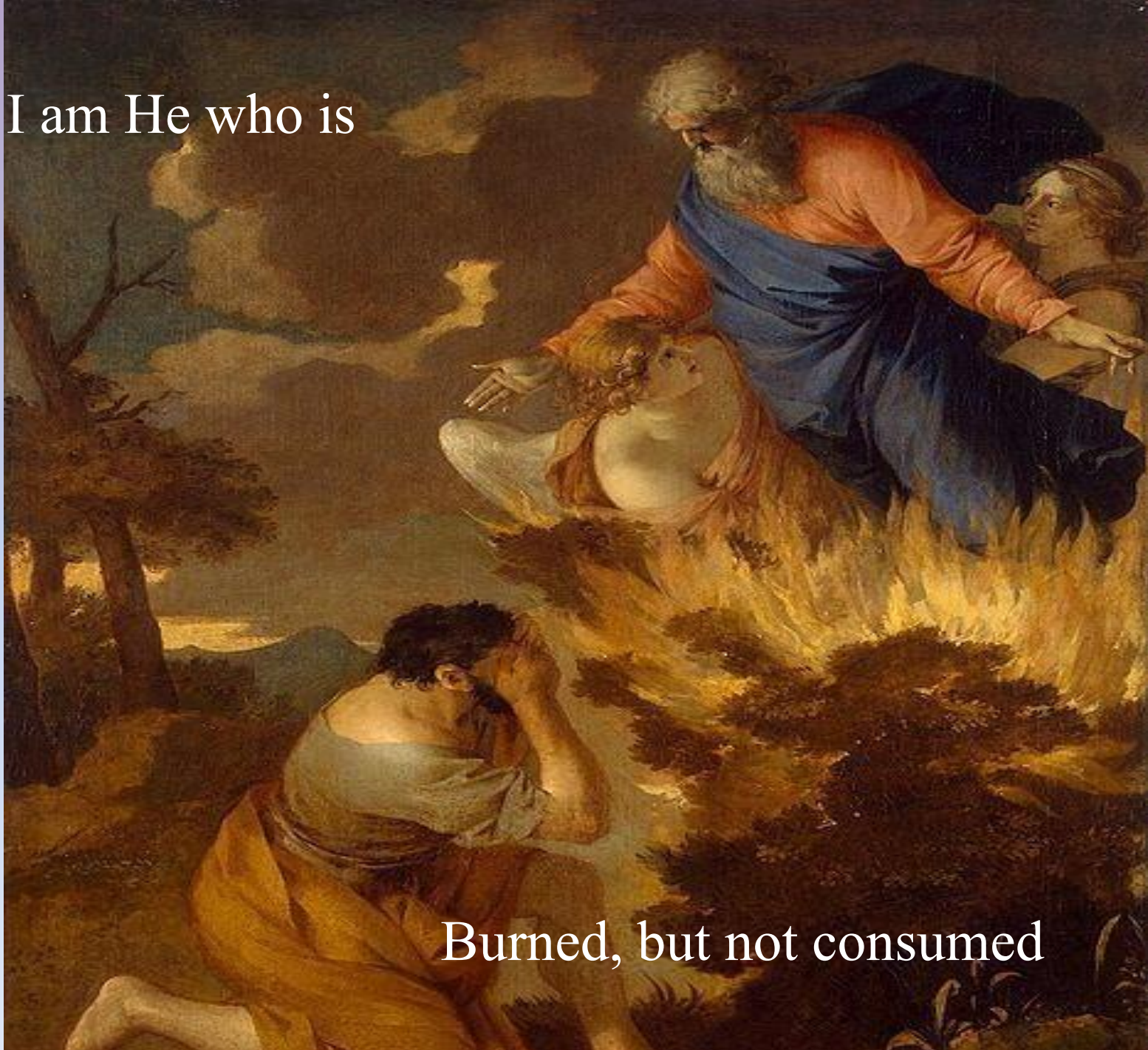

{breathe} the Holy Spirit.”





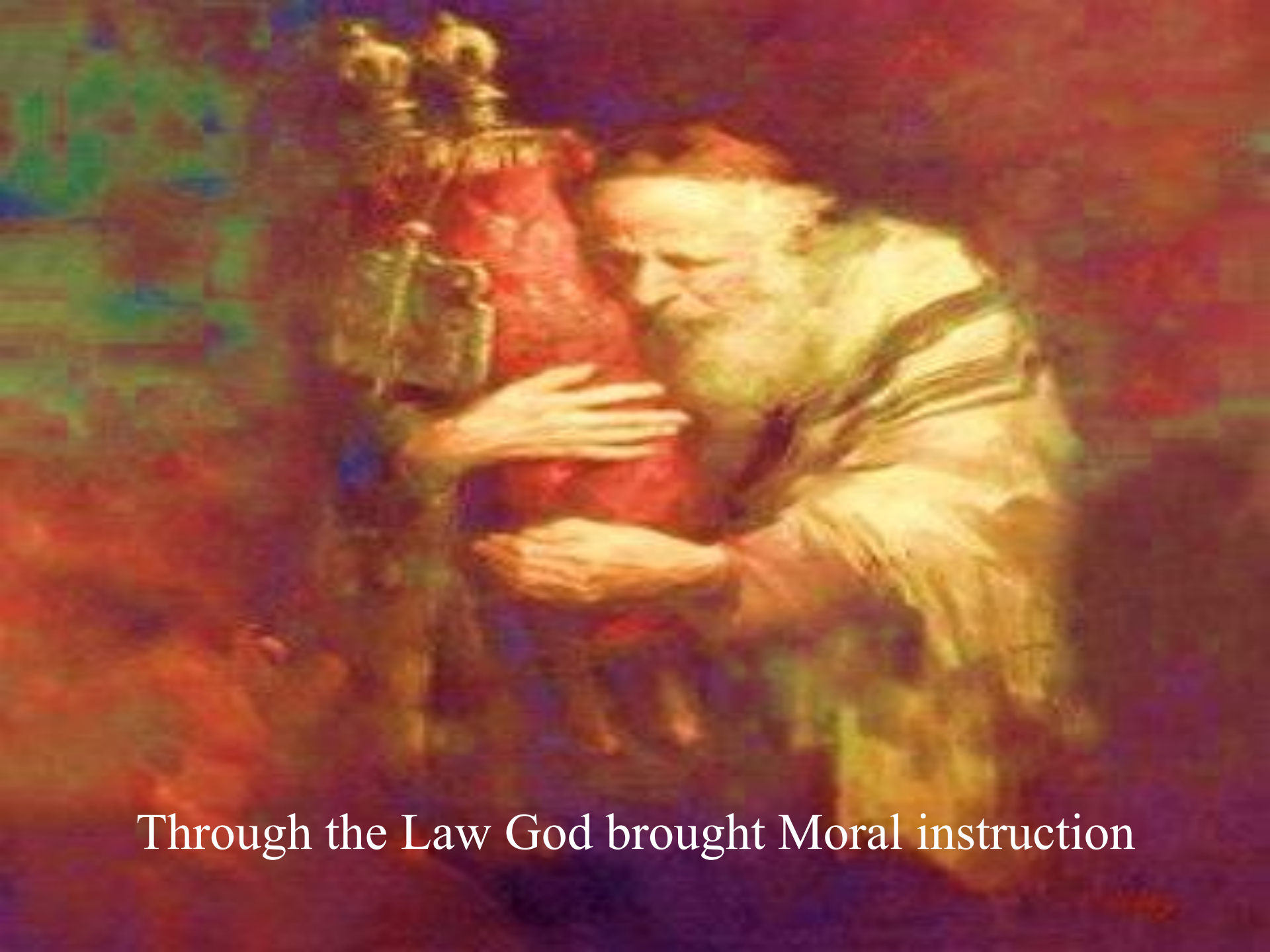
