A small Advent pilgrimage through the Gospel - Year of Faith - 2012-

First Week of Advent: Listen to the voice of Christ!

Sunday: Lk 21: 34-36 "Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy...from the anxieties of daily life."

Monday: Jn 10:1-16: "The sheep hear his voice."

Tuesday: Jn 14:23-27 "Whoever loves me will keep my word."

Wednesday: Lk 11:27-28 "Blessed are those who hear the word of God and observe it."

Thursday: Mt 6:19-21 "Where your treasure is, there also will your heart be."

Friday: Jn 6:59-69 "Only you have the words of eternal life."

Saturday: Lk 2:15-19 "Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart."

Second Week of Advent: Let us be illumined by His Light!

Sunday: Jn 1:4-9 "The Word was the true light, which enlightens everyone."

Monday: Jn 8:12: "Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness."

Tuesday: Jn 12:35-36 "Believe in the light."

Wednesday: Mt 25:1-13 "They took their lamps and filled them with oil."

Thursday: Jn 9:4-11 "We have to do the works of the one who sent me while it is day."

Friday: Jn 3:19-20: "For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come toward the light, so that his works might not be exposed."

Saturday: Mt 5:13-16 "Just so, your light must shine before others."

Third Week of Advent: Live in the logic of His Kingdom!

Sunday: Mt 5:1-12 "For theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

Monday: Mt 13:31-32 "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed."

Tuesday: Mt 13:33 "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast."

Wednesday: Mt 13:44 "The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field."

Thursday: Mt 13:45-46 "The kingdom of heaven is like a pearl of great price."

Friday: Mt 13:47-49 "The kingdom of heaven is like a net."

Saturday: Mt 6:24-34 "Seek first the kingdom of God."

Fourth Week of Advent: Be Witnesses of the Incarnation!

Sunday: Mt 2:1-12 "They saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage."

Monday: Lk 2:15-19 "The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen."

Tuesday: Lk 2:25-32 "My eyes have seen your salvation."

What is Jesus telling me through this Gospel passage? What can I learn from this passage to conform my heart and my thoughts to the logic of the Kingdom? What particular area of my life is illumined and oriented by this passage? What must I change, rectify, purify or mature so that this passage of the Gospel may come alive in me?

Let us go through the Door of Faith and prostrate ourselves before the God Child
