

SEVENTH DAY OF THE NOVENA OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA DURING THE CENTENARY OF HER APPARITIONS

We say three times like the Angel taught the little shepherds:

My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love Thee! I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love Thee.

Then we pray based on any message or event from the apparitions of Our Lady: Blessed Mother, in your third apparition, revealing the deep anguish and affliction of your Heart, you told the little shepherds: ***"You have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wants to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If you do what I tell you many souls will be saved and you will have peace. The war will end, but if you don't cease offending God, a worse one will start in the papacy of Pope Pius XI."*** How much we have to meditate on these words, Mother! You came down from Heaven to give us the necessary means to avoid great evils that threatened our souls and our history. Have we listened to you and obeyed you taking these remedies seriously and with responsibility? In Fatima you showed the little shepherds the horror of hell, you spoke to them of the seriousness of purgatory and with your presence, you made the reality of Heaven palpable. To prevent many from taking the path to perdition and from going to hell, you

asked that devotion to the Immaculate Heart be established, devotion to your maternal love which is capable of melting the most hardened and obstinate hearts. You want to save your children... You want to guard us, gather us in your Heart, you want to show us the way to heaven and you want us to live here in the love, peace, happiness, and holiness of the Kingdom.

We ask you, Mother, that by your maternal hands and through the intercession of the little shepherds, we may work arduously to promote the devotion to the Immaculate Heart, that we teach the power of Marian Consecration, of the efficacy of your maternity to form your apostles and disciples who will be, as St. Louis de Montfort says, "great saints" "taller than the cedars of Lebanon". May we not grow tired of bringing many to your Maternal Heart so that, with your maternal sweetness, maternal wisdom, and maternal authority, you may guide us to the path of full communion with Jesus. You promised in this message, that, if devotion to your Immaculate Heart is established, many souls will be saved and we will obtain peace, not only in our hearts, but in the whole world. You told us: "if you do what I tell you..." you will obtain all these graces... but if you do not stop offending God, there will be worse consequences, which have all taken place. If we had only listened, how different would the history of the 20th century have been. If we listen to you today, if we respond to your calls today, if we stop offending God today, we can be protagonists of a more luminous and peaceful history for our 21st century. We want to help you to build the plan of peace entrusted to your Immaculate Heart.



From readiness to trample on the commandments of God, deliver us.
From attempts to stifle in human hearts the very truth of God, deliver us.
From sins against the Holy Spirit, deliver us.

Accept, Oh Mother of Christ, this cry laden with the sufferings of all individual human beings, laden with the sufferings of whole societies.
Help us with the power of the Holy Spirit to conquer all sin: individual sin and the "sin of the world," in all its manifestations.
Let there be revealed, once more, in the history of the world the infinite saving power of the Redemption: the power of merciful Love! May it put a stop to evil!
May it transform consciences! May your Immaculate Heart reveal for all the light of Hope! Amen.
