


SIXTH DAY OF THE NOVENA OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA DURING THE CENTENARY OF HER APPARITIONS

We say three times like the Angel taught the little shepherds:
My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love Thee! I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love Thee."

Then we pray based on any message or event from the apparitions of Our Lady:

Blessed Mother, in your third apparition, with a saddened face you told the little shepherds: **"Sacrifice for sinners and repeat many times, especially when you make a sacrifice: O my Jesus, this is out of love for you, for the conversion of sinners and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary!"** With these words you were going to extend your hands and reveal the horror of hell. But your Maternal Heart made this call to the children and to all of us.... We must pray and make sacrifices for sinners so that they may receive the gift of conversion and choose to live in the Kingdom of God. Prayer and Sacrifice are two powerful weapons to attain the conversion of souls, to demolish the stones of the

human heart, transforming it into a new heart that is tenderer, more pure, more loving, more docile, and closer to God and His commandments. Prayer and sacrifice have the power to transform our world that is so arid and cold into a true home for the human person.

We pray blessed Mother, that from your maternal hands and through the intercession of the little shepherds, we may, like Jacinta, desire "to be the lid that seals the door to hell," so that our brothers and sisters do not go to that terrible state of separation from God for all eternity. May we be concerned for souls, their salvation, their eternal destiny. That in all of our environments, homes, communities, workplaces or social places we may care much for the eternal salvation of all. May we respond to this most urgent call that you made to the children for them to pray and sacrifice themselves for sinners, for those who are far away from God, for those who do not know His love and therefore, they do not live according to his mandates. We desire to wake ourselves up from the indifference and the coldness towards these brothers and sisters and their eternal destiny. We want to do whatever is necessary for the salvation of many, and in everything, always say that we did everything out of love for Jesus, for the conversion of these brothers and sisters and in reparation to the Immaculate Heart, in reparation to the maternal love of the Blessed Virgin Mary who is so offended, especially when we do not accept Her maternity or Her maternal calls that are always a sure remedy for the illnesses of our heart or for the evils of our world and of our history.

From every kind of injustice in the life of society, both national and international, deliver us.
From readiness to trample on the commandments of God, deliver us.
From attempts to stifle in human hearts the very truth of God, deliver us.
From sins against the Holy Spirit, deliver us.

Accept, Oh Mother of Christ, this cry laden with the sufferings of all individual human beings, laden with the sufferings of whole societies.
Help us with the power of the Holy Spirit to conquer all sin: individual sin and the "sin of the world," in all its manifestations.
Let there be revealed, once more, in the history of the world the infinite saving power of the Redemption: the power of merciful Love! May it put a stop to evil!
May it transform consciences! May your Immaculate Heart reveal for all the light of Hope! Amen.
