

## 14 PROMISES GIVEN BY JESUS TO THOSE WHO PRAY THE CHAPLET OF MERCY



14 Amazing Promises Jesus Made to Those who Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet. The Divine Mercy Chaplet was presented to Saint Faustina in 1935 during a private revelation. Jesus asks that we meditate upon His Passion at 3 o'clock in the afternoon. The Divine Mercy Chaplet is an especially powerful way to bring our hearts to the contemplation of Christ Passion and to ask for mercy through his sorrowful passion and sacrifice to save humanity.

Here are the 14 promises Jesus made to those who pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet:

(1) **Say the chaplet I have taught you, and the storm will cease.** I began immediately to say the chaplet and hadn't even finished it when the storm suddenly ceased, and I heard the words: **"Through the chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will.** (1731)

(2) **This prayer will serve to appease My wrath.** (476) God's justice is mitigated (811). This chaplet mitigates God's anger at so much sin committed by humanity, as He Himself told me. (1036)

(3) **The Powers of Darkness Fled in a Panic.** When I entered the chapel for a moment, the Lord said to me, My daughter, help Me to save a certain dying sinner. Say the chaplet that I have taught you for him. When I began to say the chaplet, I saw the man dying in the midst of terrible torment and struggle. His Guardian Angel was defending him, but he was, as it were, powerless against the enormity of the soul's misery. A multitude of devils was waiting for the soul. But while I was saying the chaplet, I saw Jesus just as He is depicted in the image. The rays which issued from Jesus' Heart enveloped the sick man, and the powers of darkness fled in panic. The sick man peacefully breathed his last. When I came to myself, I understood how very important the chaplet was for the dying. It appeases the anger of God. (1565)

(4) **"Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death."** (Diary of Saint Faustina, 687)

(5) **"Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation.** Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy... I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy." (Diary of Saint Faustina, 687)

(6) **"The souls that say this chaplet will be embraced by My mercy during their lifetime** and especially at the hour of their death." (Diary of Saint Faustina, 754)

(7) **"Souls who spread the honor of My mercy... at the hour of death I will not be a Judge for them, but the Merciful Savior."** (Diary of Saint Faustina, 1075)

(8) **"The prayer most pleasing to Me is prayer for the conversion for sinners.** Know, my daughter, that this prayer is always heard and answered." (Diary of Saint Faustina, 1397)

(9) **"My mercy is greater than your sins and those of the entire world."** (Diary of Saint Faustina, 1485)

(10) **"To priests who proclaim and extol My mercy, I will give wondrous power;** I will anoint their words and touch the hearts of those to whom they will speak." (Diary of Saint Faustina, 1521)

(11) **"Through this chaplet, you will obtain everything,** if what you ask for is compatible with My will." (Diary of Saint Faustina, 1731)

(12) **"When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace,** and the hour of their death will be a happy one." (1541)

(13) **"When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying,** I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as a just Judge but as a merciful Savior." (Diary of Saint Faustina, 1541)

(14) **"At three o'clock, implore My mercy, especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony... I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion."** (Diary of Saint Faustina, 1320)
